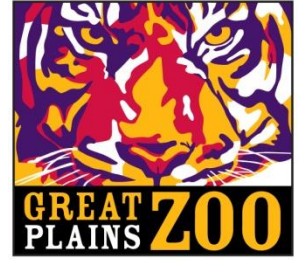


Summer ZooCamp 2022

Camps for ages 6 to 8

Home Sweet Habitat (5 full days) – \$199.75 for Zoo members / \$235 for non-members
